# **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

All courses feature varied terrain, rolling hills, and mostly grassy footing. There is no pavement and very little gravel. All parts of each course feature enough width to accommodate many runners at one time. There are no single track or bottle neck areas. The start line and finish line will be in different areas. The start line will be close to the grass ring across the dirt lane way, and the finish area will be in the little parking lot close to the concession.

## **CANCELLATION DATE:**

Even though cross country meets run rain or shine, there is a likelihood that we may have a lot of snow on the ground by this date. If this ends up being the case, this race will be postponed to another date.
